


Prioritization vs. Estimates

- Anthrax: for 65 countries was a priority,
 1 national study
- Rabies: for 94 countries was a priority,
 11 studies
- Campylobacter: for 5 countries was a priority, 21 studies
- Toxoplasmosis: for 7 countries was a priority, 15 studies



NZDs and DALYs

- 17 NZDs included in the DALYs estimates
- How many DALYs are missing?
 - Bigger initiative to help understand the «real» burden
 - Enhance comparison and embrace the complexity of these diseases

- Mismatched between prioritization and findings
- Broadening the scope of existing projects
- Discover the real burden of NZDs
