

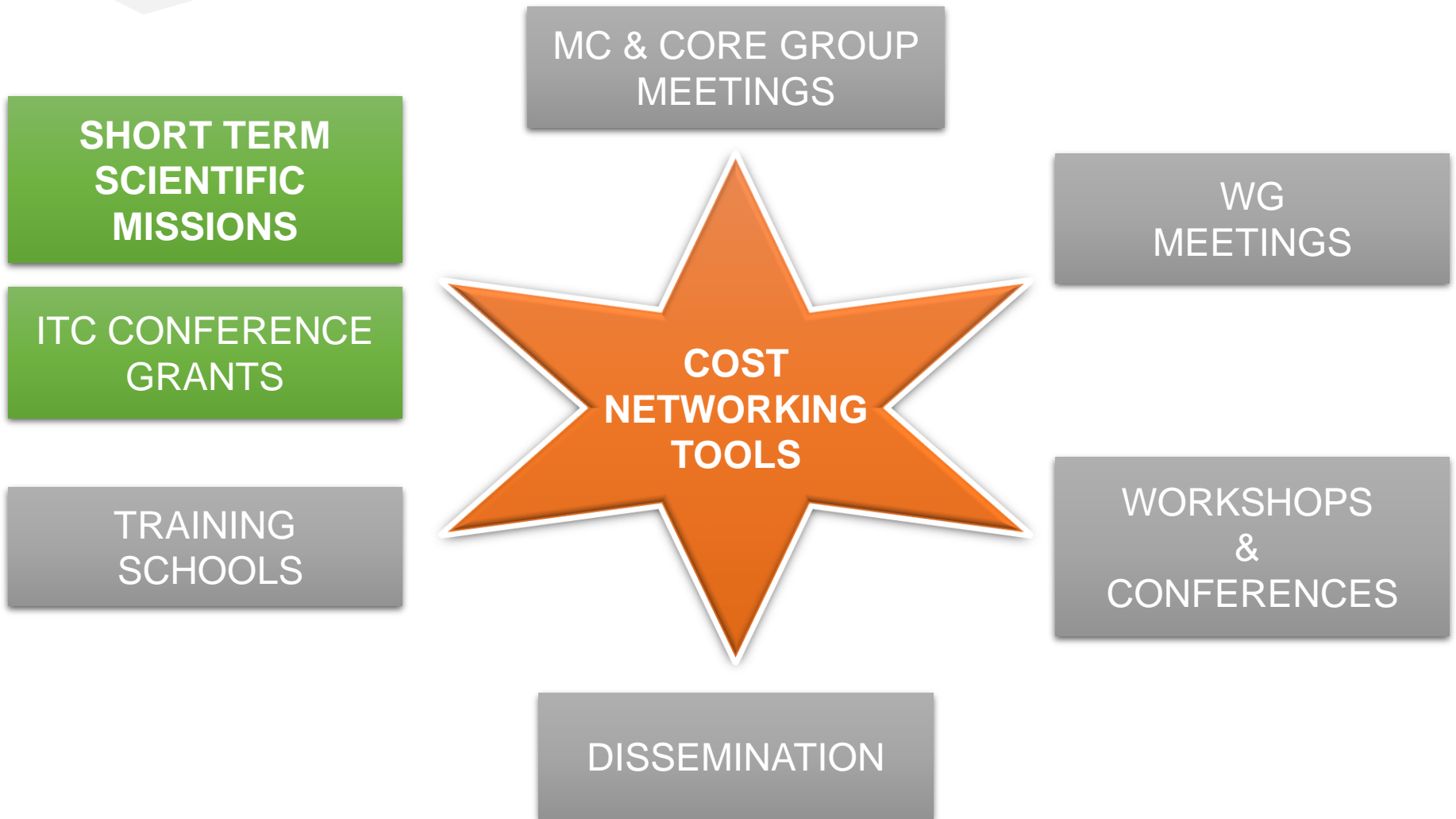

COST Networking Tools



Short-term scientific missions

- Exchange visits fostering collaboration, contributing to the scientific objectives of the Action and allowing participants to learn new techniques, to have access to data/instruments/methods not available in their own institution
- Duration
 - 5-90 days including travel
 - ECIs: up to 180 days
- Should fall within one grant period

STSM financial support

- Financial support = fixed contribution (grant)
- No receipts needed
- Max 3500 EUR in total
 - Max 160 EUR per day (hotel, meals)
 - Max 300 EUR for travel
- Payment after approval of scientific report
- Researchers from participating ITCs
 - 50% of the grant upon completion of 1st day

STSM procedures

- Applicants must make necessary contacts with host institution themselves
- Application procedure
 - STSM application form
 - Recent CV
 - Letter (email) of invitation from STSM supervisor
 - Letter (email) of support from home institution
- Evaluation by STSM coordinator
- Upon approval: submit STSM application online (<https://www.cost.eu/stsm>)

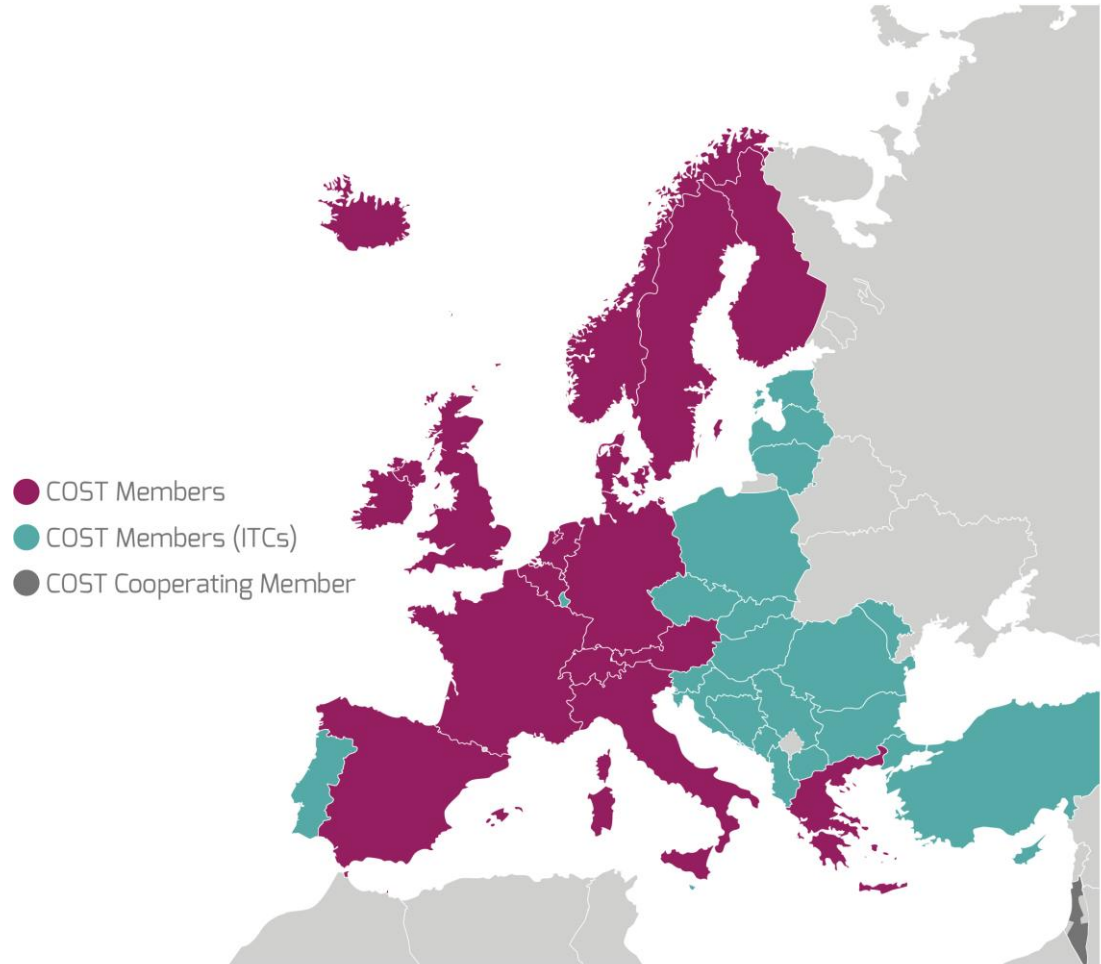

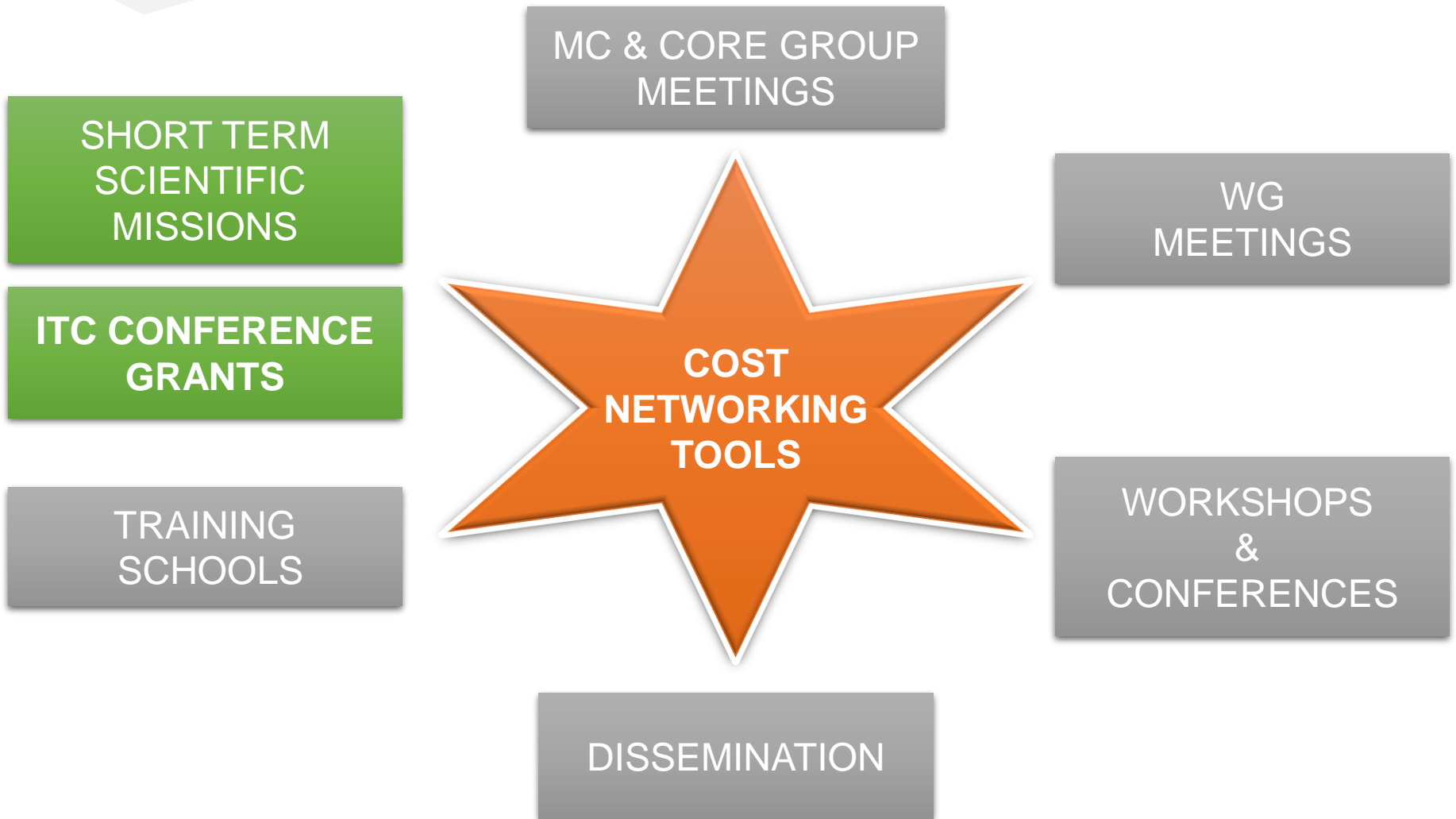

- Approval by the ITC-CG Coordinator
- Financial support: grant up to EUR 2500 paid after the event
